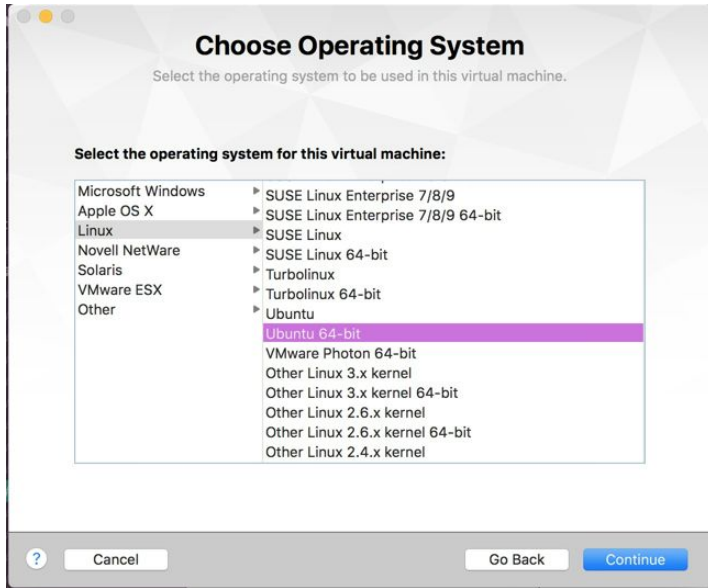


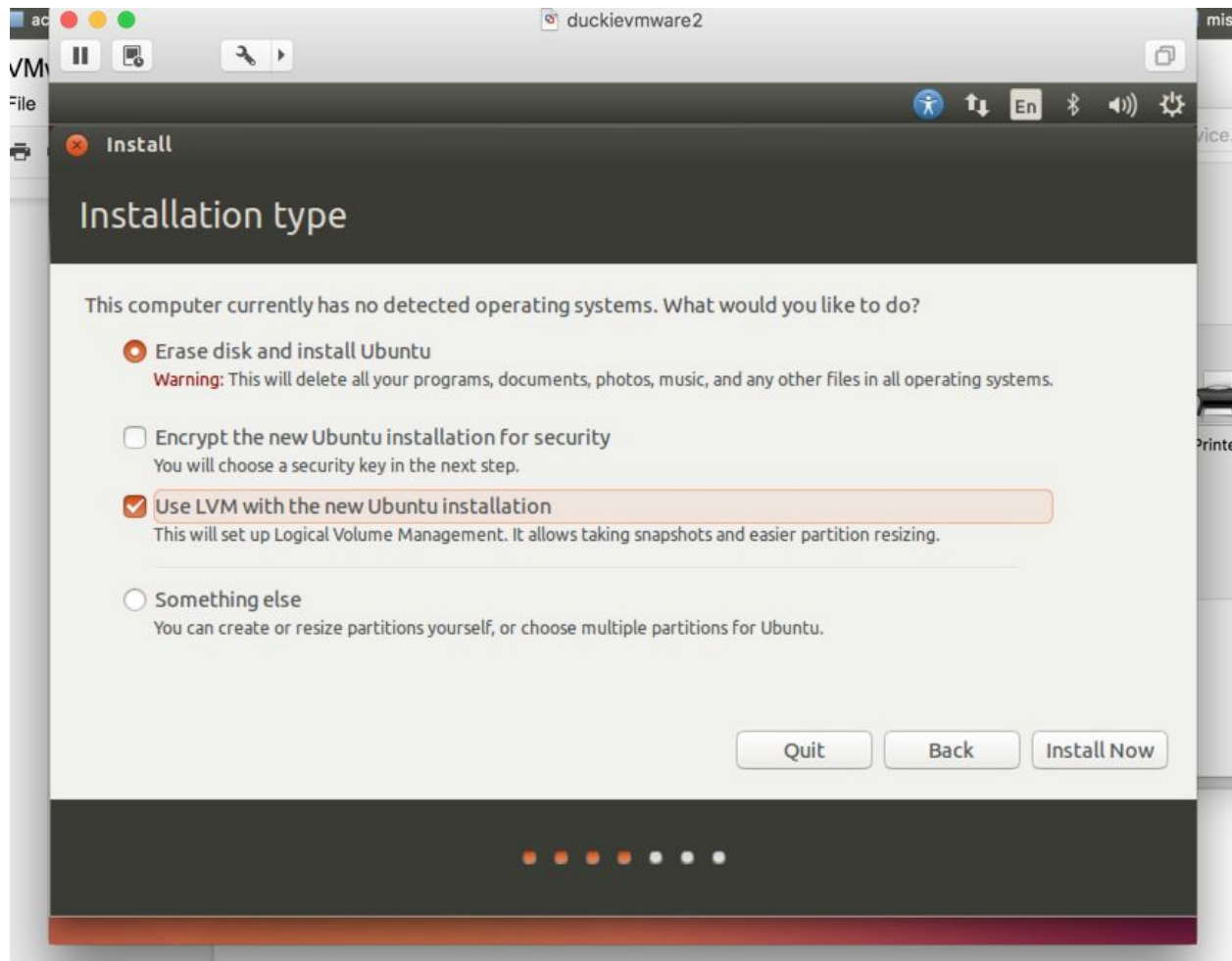
## Installation using VMWare

- Download from: <http://releases.ubuntu.com/14.04/>. Use [ubuntu-14.04.3-desktop-amd64.iso.torrent](#).
- Create new VM, using Ubuntu 64-bit.



- 20 GB is fine





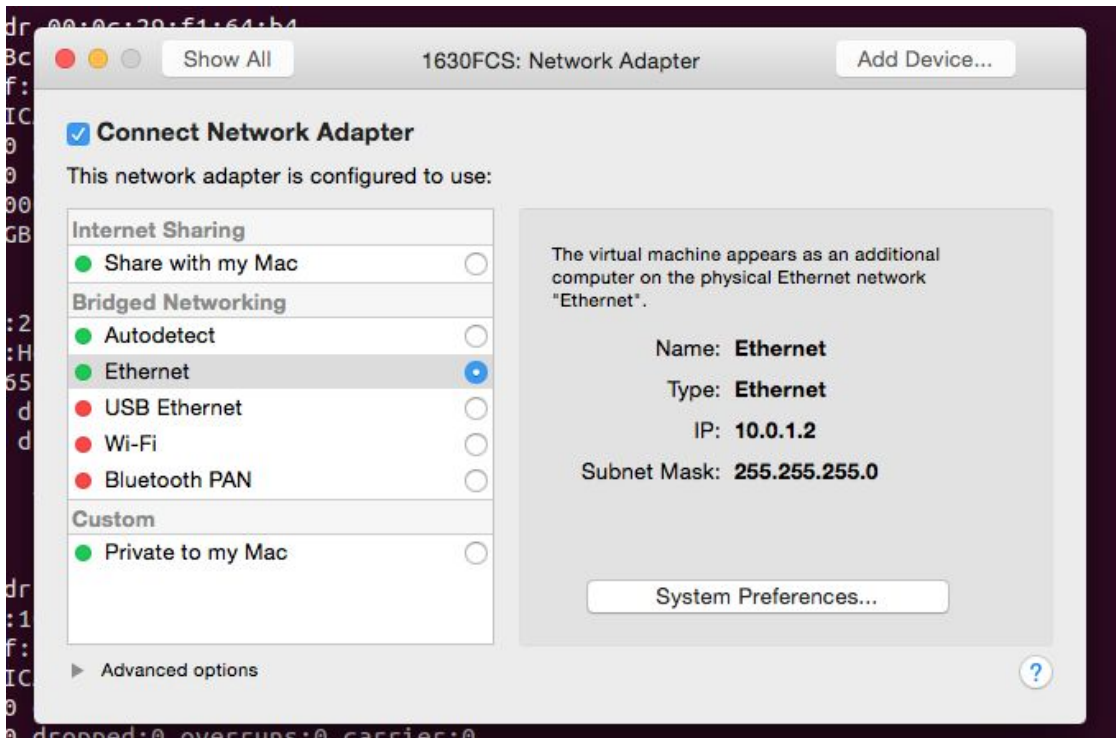
## Network setup

To assign your virtual machine to have the same IP address as your computer:

Select Virtual Machine, Settings... and you will see this screen below



Select Network Adapter and you will see the screen below. The default setting is “Share with my mac”. Set it instead to “Ethernet”



## Mounting Dropbox from VMWare

- 1) Use settings for VMWare to share the folders.
- 2) In the VM, make sure that this gives the names of the folders:

```
$ vmware-hgfsclient
```

```
duckietown-data
```

### 3) Mount the folders

```
sudo apt-get install open-vm-tools
```

```
cd /mnt
```

```
sudo mkdir hgfs
```

```
sudo vmware-hgfsmounter .host:/`vmware-hgfsclient` /mnt/hgfs
```
