Take a Log with a Duckiebot



- 1. Put usb stick in
- 2. Run mount and verify it's not mounted already
- 3. Run dmesg, look for the device name (ex: sda)
- 4. Create directory /mnt/logs
 - a. sudo mkdir -p /mnt/logs
- 5. Mount the directory
 - a. sudo mount -o umask=000 /dev/sda1 /mnt/logs
- 6. Create a file in /mnt/logs to check the permissions are correct
 - a. touch /mnt/logs/test.log
- 7. To unmount it (you and all sessions on the machine must not be inside the /mnt/logs folder for this to work)
