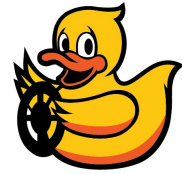


# Take a Log with a Duckiebot



1. Put usb stick in
2. Run mount and verify it's not mounted already
3. Run dmesg, look for the device name (ex: sda)
4. Create directory /mnt/logs
  - a. `sudo mkdir -p /mnt/logs`
5. Mount the directory
  - a. `sudo mount -o umask=000 /dev/sda1 /mnt/logs`
6. Create a file in /mnt/logs to check the permissions are correct
  - a. `touch /mnt/logs/test.log`
7. To unmount it (you and all sessions on the machine must not be inside the /mnt/logs folder for this to work)
